1 Section 1. Section ninety-three point two (93.2), Code  
2 1975, is amended to read as follows:

3 93.2 ESTABLISHMENT. There is established an energy policy  
4 council which shall consist of ~~thirteen~~ fifteen members.  
5 Two members shall be appointed by the president of the senate  
6 from the membership of the senate with no more than one member  
7 being appointed from the same political party. Two members  
8 shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of  
9 representatives from the members of the house with no more  
10 than one member being appointed from the same political party.  
11 The governor shall appoint five members who shall be reasonably  
12 knowledgeable in the field of energy. Not more than three  
13 of the governor's appointees shall be of the same political  
14 party. They shall be subject to confirmation by two-thirds  
15 of the membership of the senate. The state geologist, the  
16 secretary of agriculture, the chairman of the Iowa state  
17 commerce commission, the administrative officer of the state  
18 soil conservation committee, the director of transportation  
19 and the executive director of environmental quality shall  
20 serve as ex officio nonvoting members of the council.

21 EXPLANATION

22 This bill adds two additional ex officio nonvoting members  
23 to the energy policy council.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE ENERGY POLICY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section ninety-three point two (93.2), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

93.2 ESTABLISHMENT. There is established an energy policy council which shall consist of ~~thirteen~~ fifteen members. Two members shall be appointed by the president of the senate from the membership of the senate with no more than one member being appointed from the same political party. Two members shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives from the members of the house with no more than one member being appointed from the same political party. The governor shall appoint five members who shall be reasonably knowledgeable in the field of energy. Not more than three of the governor's appointees shall be of the same political party. They shall be subject to confirmation by two-thirds of the membership of the senate. The state geologist, the secretary of agriculture, the chairman of the Iowa state commerce commission, the administrative officer of the state soil conservation committee, the director of transportation and the executive director of environmental quality shall serve as ex officio nonvoting members of the council. If an ex officio nonvoting member is unable to attend a meeting of the council, the member shall designate a replacement

who shall be authorized to represent the member at the meeting.
