BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Sections fourteen point six (14.6), seventeen point twenty-one (17.21), seventeen point twenty-two (17.22), seventeen point twenty-seven (17.27), and seventeen A point six (17A.6), eighteen point ninety-seven (18.97), as appearing in the Code 1975, shall be in effect on the effective date of this Act.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Pella Chronicle, a newspaper published in Pella, Iowa, and in the Carroll Daily Times Herald, a newspaper published in Carroll, Iowa.
