1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the Iowa state civil rights commission for  
3 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30,  
4 1976 the sum of two hundred thirty-two thousand eight hundred  
5 sixty-four (232,864) dollars, or so much thereof as is  
6 necessary, to be used for salaries, support, maintenance,  
7 and miscellaneous purposes.

8 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
9 of the agency appropriated funds under this Act are  
10 appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants  
11 or receipts.

12 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight  
13 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or  
14 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for  
15 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30,  
16 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976.  
17 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point  
18 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This appropriation is intended to allow the Iowa state  
21 civil rights commission to continue its present programs with  
22 an allowance for inflation and also the bill funds one  
23 additional full-time civil rights field representative. The  
24 bill allows for use of an automobile for this person. Salaries  
25 are funded at present levels with no allowance for inflation.

26 pursuant to, the provisions of chapter seventeen A  
27 (17A) of the Code. The attorney general may inter-  
28 vene in the action if the attorney general determines  
29 the case is of general public importance."

AN ACT  
MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE IOWA STATE CIVIL RIGHTS  
COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the Iowa state civil rights commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the sum of two hundred forty-nine thousand one hundred nineteen (249,119) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes.

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agency appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
