3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year designated the following
3 amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the agencies
4 and purposes specified:

7 1. IOWA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

8 a. For salaries, support, main-
9 tenance, promotion and miscellaneous

10 purposes \$1,476,891

11 b. The Iowa development commission shall allocate from
12 funds appropriated by paragraph a of this subsection not to
13 exceed thirty thousand (30,000) dollars for the seven regional
14 tourism districts, not to exceed five thousand (5,000) dollars
15 per district, if the district which will receive such funds
16 provides on a dollar-to-dollar matching basis funds equal
17 to the amount allocated by the Iowa development commission.
18 Application for aid under this paragraph shall be made to
19 the Iowa development commission in a manner determined by
20 the commission.

21 c. Funds appropriated by paragraph a of this subsection
22 shall be used to pay salaries and support for a table of
23 organization of not more than forty-four permanent full-time
24 positions.

28 b. Funds appropriated by this subsection shall be used
29 to pay salaries and support for a table of organization of
30 not more than nine permanent full-time positions.

31 Sec. 2. Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be used
32 to fund capital improvements.

33 Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
34 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appro-
35 priated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants

1 or receipts.

2 Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
3 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
4 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
5 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30,
6 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976.
7 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point
8 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.

9 EXPLANATION

10 1. The appropriation made by this Act to the energy policy
11 council will be used to provide funds to provide salaries
12 and support for nine current positions.

13 2. Contained within the appropriation of \$1,476,891 to
14 the Iowa development commission is \$50,992 for the community
15 betterment program. This program was transferred to the
16 commission from the office for planning and programming on
17 January 1, 1975. An increase of two employees is provided
18 for the Iowa development commission for program expansion.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE IOWA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION AND ENERGY POLICY COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year designated the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the agencies and purposes specified:

Fiscal Year

1. IOWA DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

a. For salaries, support, maintenance, promotion and miscellaneous purposes \$1,476,891

b. The Iowa development commission shall allocate from funds appropriated by paragraph a of this subsection not to exceed thirty thousand (30,000) dollars for the seven regional tourism districts, not to exceed five thousand (5,000) dollars per district, if the district which will receive such funds provides on a dollar-to-dollar matching basis funds equal to the amount allocated by the Iowa development commission. Application for aid under this paragraph shall be made to the Iowa development commission in a manner determined by the commission.

c. Funds appropriated by paragraph a of this subsection shall be used to pay salaries and support for a table of organization of not more than forty-seven permanent full-time positions.

2. ENERGY POLICY COUNCIL

a. For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes \$ 196,178

b. Funds appropriated by this subsection shall be used to pay salaries and support for a table of organization of _____

not more than nine permanent full-time positions.

Sec. 2. Funds appropriated by this Act shall not be used to fund capital improvements.

Sec. 3. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.

Sec. 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976. In all other respects the provisions of section eight point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.
