A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to expenses for persons seeking or employed
2 in professional positions with the state.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Chapter seventy-nine (79), Code 1975, is amended
2 by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. INTERVIEW OR MOVING EXPENSES. If approved
4 by the appointing or employing authority, a person who
5 interviews for a professional position with the state shall
6 be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the interview at the
7 same rate provided for state employees for reimbursement for
8 expenses for state business. If approved by the appointing
9 or employing authority, a person who is hired in a professional
10 position with the state shall receive reimbursement for moving
11 expenses incurred after the time the person is hired.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill allows the payment of expenses incurred by persons
14 who interview for professional positions with the state.
15 In addition it allows the payment of moving expenses for
16 professional employees who are hired by the state. Payment
17 for expenses would first have to be authorized by the
18 appointing or employing authority, which would allow for a
19 determination that the expenses are payable within budget
20 limitations of such authority.

AN ACT
RELATING TO EXPENSES FOR PERSONS SEEKING OR EMPLOYED IN
POSITIONS WITH THE STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter seventy-nine (79), Code 1975, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. INTERVIEW OR MOVING EXPENSES. If approved by the appointing or employing authority, a person who interviews for a position with the state shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred in the interview at the same rate provided for state employees for reimbursement for expenses for state business. If approved by the appointing or employing authority, a person who is hired in a position with the state shall receive reimbursement for moving expenses incurred after the time the person is hired. However, expenses incurred in moving this person's household goods and other personal effects shall be reimbursed only to the extent the expense is for the packing and moving of ten thousand pounds or less of these goods and effects. Also, reimbursement for moving expenses shall not include reimbursement for the expense of moving animals.
