1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and
3 ending June 30, 1976 the following amounts, or so much thereof
4 as is necessary to the following legislative agencies and
5 the pioneer lawmakers, the code editor, and the commission
6 on uniform state laws:

26 Sec. 2. Section twenty-eight B point four (28B.4), Code
27 1975, is amended to read as follows:

28 28B.4 REPORT. The commission shall report to the governor
29 and to the legislature within fifteen days after the convening
30 of each general assembly, and at such other time as it deems
31 appropriate. Its members and the members of all committees
32 which it establishes shall be reimbursed for their travel
33 and other necessary expenses in carrying out their obligations
34 under this chapter and legislative members shall be paid a
35 per diem of forty dollars for each day in which engaged in

1 the performance of their duties, such per diem and legislators'
2 expenses to be paid from funds appropriated by ~~section~~ sections
3 two point ten (2.10) and 2.12 of the Code. Expenses of
4 administrative officers, state officials, or state employees
5 who are members of the Iowa commission on interstate
6 cooperation or a committee appointed by the commission shall
7 be paid from funds appropriated to the agencies or departments
8 which such persons represent except as may otherwise be
9 provided by the general assembly. Expenses of citizen members
10 who may be appointed to committees of the commission may be
11 paid from funds as authorized by the general assembly.
12 Expenses of the secretary or employees of the secretary and
13 support services in connection with the administration of
14 the commission shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
15 legislative service bureau unless otherwise provided by the
16 general assembly. Expenses of commission members shall be
17 paid upon approval of the chairman or the secretary of the
18 commission.

19 Sec. 3. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used
20 for capital improvements.

21 Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts
22 of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are
23 appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants
24 or receipts.

25 Sec. 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section eight
26 point thirty-three (8.33) of the Code, all unencumbered or
27 unobligated balances of appropriations made by this Act for
28 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 remaining on June 30,
29 1976 shall revert to the general fund on August 31, 1976.
30 In all other respects the provisions of section eight point
31 thirty-three (8.33) of the Code shall apply to this Act.

32 EXPLANATION

33 1. Legislative Fiscal Bureau. This appropriation in the
34 amount of \$201,550 funds the nine positions now filled and
35 provides support and maintenance for those positions. In

1 addition, one new position is added. Positions now funded
2 by the legislature are being transferred to the Legislative
3 Fiscal Bureau as permanent full-time employees.

4 2. Legislative Service Bureau. This appropriation in
5 the amount of \$441,844 funds 22 positions on the present
6 payroll plus 3 positions being transferred from the legislative
7 payroll to permanent full-time employees of the Service Bureau.
8 Two of the positions being transferred have been on the Service
9 Bureau payroll during interim periods but would now be on
10 such payroll full-time.

11 3. Pioneer Lawmakers. This appropriation of \$75 helps
12 defray the expense of the organization.

13 4. Code Editor. This appropriation in the amount of
14 \$54,072 funds 4 positions on the current authorized table
15 of organization and allows support and maintenance for those
16 four positions.

17 5. Commission on Uniform State Laws. This appropriation
18 of \$7,400 funds Iowa's assessment for participation in the
19 amount of \$5,600 and \$1,800 for travel of the 3 member
20 Commission.

21 6. Commission on Interstate Cooperation. No funds are
22 specifically appropriated for the Commission on Interstate
23 Cooperation but section 2 provides a funding mechanism for
24 the Commission in the same manner as is being considered for
25 other agencies and boards on which legislators serve in other
26 legislation presently before the general assembly. Chapter
27 28B provides for administrative officials serving on the
28 Commission and these persons would be funded through
29 appropriations to their departments unless the general assembly
30 would otherwise provide, such as through an allocation of
31 funds or a specific appropriation. Chapter 28B also provides
32 for appointment of other committees by the Commission upon
33 which citizen members could conceivably serve; section 2 again
34 provides that such citizen members could be paid by action
35 of the general assembly. Overhead expenses are generally

1 minimal for the Commission and will be absorbed by the
2 Legislative Service Bureau pursuant to section 2 unless the
3 general assembly should otherwise provide. The secretary
4 of the Commission is designated by chapter 28B to be the
5 director of the Legislative Service Bureau.

AN ACT

RELATING TO AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES
AND AGENCIES INVOLVED IN THE LEGISLATIVE PROCESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976 the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary to the following legislative agencies and the pioneer lawmakers, the code editor, and the commission on uniform state laws:

Sec. 2. Section twenty-eight B point four (28B.4), Code 1975, is amended to read as follows:

28B.4 REPORT. The commission shall report to the governor and to the legislature within fifteen days after the convening

of each general assembly, and at such other time as it deems appropriate. Its members and the members of all committees which it establishes shall be reimbursed for their travel and other necessary expenses in carrying out their obligations under this chapter and legislative members shall be paid a per diem of forty dollars for each day in which engaged in the performance of their duties, such per diem and legislators' expenses to be paid from funds appropriated by ~~section~~ sections two point ten (2.10) and 2.12 of the Code. Expenses of administrative officers, state officials, or state employees who are members of the Iowa commission on interstate cooperation or a committee appointed by the commission shall be paid from funds appropriated to the agencies or departments which such persons represent except as may otherwise be provided by the general assembly. Expenses of citizen members who may be appointed to committees of the commission may be paid from funds as authorized by the general assembly. Expenses of the secretary or employees of the secretary and support services in connection with the administration of the commission shall be paid from funds appropriated to the legislative service bureau unless otherwise provided by the general assembly. Expenses of commission members shall be paid upon approval of the chairman or the secretary of the commission.

Sec. 3. Moneys appropriated by this Act shall not be used for capital improvements.

Sec. 4. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agencies appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
