1 An Act appropriating funds to the office of the citizens' aide.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Amend Senate File 563, as passed by the Senate,  
2 as follows:

3 1. Page 1, line 9, by striking the figures  
4 "104,150" and inserting in lieu thereof the figures  
5 "120,150".

6 2. Page 1, by inserting after line 13 the  
7 following new section:

8 "Sec. 3. Section six hundred one G point six  
9 (601G.6), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1975,  
10 is amended to read as follows:

11 The citizens' aide shall appoint an assistant  
12 who shall be responsible for investigating complaints  
13 relating only to penal or correctional agencies and  
14 shall appoint another assistant who shall be re-  
15 sponsible for investigating complaints relating only  
16 to Indian problems. A person who is an assistant  
17 of Indian problems shall have knowledge of American  
18 Indian cultures and the problems of American Indians  
19 living in this state."

#### Explanation of Amendment

The additional \$16,000 allowed under this amendment is for the salary and expenses of an assistant for Indian problems.

2 of the state to the office of citizens' aide for the fiscal  
3 year beginning July 1, 1975, and ending June 30, 1976, the  
4 following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be

10 Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts  
11 of the agency appropriated funds under this Act are appro-

13 or receipts.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This appropriation of \$104,150 funds the positions on the  
16 current table of organization and provides support funds as  
17 follows: Travel, \$6,000; Office supplies and expense, \$6,000;  
18 Printing and binding, \$1,200; Telephone, \$3,780; and  
19 Professional and scientific service, \$1,300. The deputy for  
20 corrections position will be funded on a 50-50 ratio for  
21 fiscal year 1976 with federal funds.

AN ACT  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF THE CITIZENS' AIDF.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the office of citizens' aide for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975, and ending June 30, 1976, the following amount, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

For salaries, support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes ..... \$ 120,150

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agency appropriated funds under this Act are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants or receipts.
