A BILL FOR

1 An Act establishing salary rates for members of the judicial
2 branch of government and the members of the public
3 employment relations board.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. The salary rates established in this Act shall
2 be in effect for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1975 and
3 ending June 30, 1976. Persons receiving the salary rates
4 established by this Act shall not receive any salary
5 adjustments pursuant to any other Act approved by the general
6 assembly and where this Act conflicts with any other provisions
7 of law, this Act shall govern for the fiscal year beginning
8 July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976. Salaries provided
9 for in this Act shall be paid from funds appropriated to the
10 agency which the person represents or for which the person
11 is employed, however if the funds of the agency which have
12 been appropriated for salaries are insufficient to pay the
13 salaries fixed by this Act because of increases in such
14 salaries, funds may be allocated from funds appropriated by
15 the general assembly for salary adjustment purposes. In
16 addition, if federal funds are available for any position
17 provided for in this Act, such federal funds may be expended
18 if the combined federal and state funds do not exceed the
19 rates provided for in this Act.
