A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation to the Iowa American revolution
2 bicentennial commission to finance the participation of Iowa
3 musical groups in honor of Iowa statehood at the Kennedy
4 Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated for the fiscal year
 2 ending June 30, 1976 from the general fund of the state, the
 3 sum of seventeen thousand (17,000) dollars, or so much thereof
 4 as is necessary, to the Iowa bicentennial commission. Funds
 5 appropriated by this Act shall be used to pay expenses
 6 including, but not limited to transportation, lodging,
 7 equipment, supplies, mailings, telephone, and honorarium costs
 8 incurred in participating in a performance to honor Iowa
 9 composers and Iowa statehood at the Kennedy Center for the
 10 Performing Arts located in Washington, D.C., to be held on
 11 May 31, 1976. Funds appropriated by this Act shall be used
 12 to pay the expenses of an Iowa choral group, chamber music
 13 group, and solists and duos. Costs incurred shall be subject
 14 to the same budgetary procedures as are other costs of the
 15 Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission.
 16 Unencumbered or unobligated funds appropriated by this Act
 17 remaining on June 30, 1976 shall revert to the general fund
 18 of the state on August 31, 1976.

19 EXPLANATION

20 This bill provides funds for the financing through the
 21 Iowa American revolution bicentennial commission Iowa's
 22 participation in a performance to be held May 31, 1976 in
 23 Washington, D.C. in a musical performance honoring Iowa
 24 composers and Iowa statehood.
