EXPLANATION

13
14 This bill appropriates funds for claims filed against the
15 state which were referred to the general assembly by the state
16 appeal board. Section 25.3 of the Code provides for the state
17 appeal board to file with the general assembly a list of all
18 claims rejected by the state appeal board and other
19 information. This bill represents the action of the claims
20 committee of the House and Senate in approving such claims.

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
