1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the department of social services for the  
3 fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act  
4 and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of eight million (8,000,000)  
5 dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, which shall be  
6 used only to supplement existing appropriations for the medical  
7 assistance program maintained under chapter two hundred forty-  
8 nine A (249A) of the Code.

9 Sec. 2. Any unencumbered or unexpended funds not used  
10 for the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act and  
11 remaining on June 30, 1977, shall revert to the general fund  
12 of the state. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-  
13 nine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall  
14 not be subject to transfer or expenditure and used for any  
15 purpose other than the purpose specified in section one (1)  
16 of this Act.

17 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
18 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-  
19 tion in the Iowa City Press-Citizen, <sup>3/18/77</sup> a newspaper published  
20 in Iowa City, Iowa, and in The Bancroft Register, <sup>2/16/77</sup> a newspaper  
21 published in Bancroft, Iowa.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill provides an emergency appropriation to supplement  
24 existing appropriations for the remainder of fiscal year 1976-  
25 1977 in order to provide additional funds for medical  
26 assistance.

AN ACT

MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services for the fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1977, the sum of eight million (8,000,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, which shall be used only to supplement existing appropriations for the medical assistance program maintained under chapter two hundred forty-nine A (249A) of the Code.

Sec. 2. Any unencumbered or unexpended funds not used for the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act and remaining on June 30, 1977, shall revert to the general fund of the state. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-nine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall not be subject to transfer or expenditure and used for any purpose other than the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act.

Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Iowa City Press-Citizen, a newspaper published
