1 Section 1. Section one hundred six point five (106.5),  
2 subsection seven (7), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

3 7. If the owner of a currently registered vessel places  
4 such vessel in storage, he shall return the registration  
5 certificate to the county recorder with an affidavit stating  
6 that the vessel is placed in storage and the effective date  
7 of such storage. The county recorder shall notify the com-  
8 mission of each registered vessel placed in storage. When  
9 the owner of a stored vessel desires to renew the vessel's  
10 registration, he shall make application to the county recorder  
11 and pay the registration fees as provided in subsections 1  
12 and 3 without penalty. No refund of registration fees shall  
13 be allowed for a stored vessel.

14 Sec. 2. Section one hundred six point six (106.6),  
15 subsection four (4), Code 1977, is amended by striking the  
16 subsection.

17 Sec. 3. This Act shall be effective January 1, 1978.

18 EXPLANATION

19 Section 1 of the bill provides that the procedures for  
20 the storage of registered vessels applies only to currently  
21 registered vessels. Section 2 of the bill strikes the  
22 exemption from registration for vessels having a valid marine  
23 document issued by the bureau of customs of the United States  
24 government or any successor agency.

AN ACT  
RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF VESSELS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section one hundred six point five (106.5), subsection seven (7), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

7. If the owner of a currently registered vessel places such vessel in storage, he shall return the registration certificate to the county recorder with an affidavit stating that the vessel is placed in storage and the effective date of such storage. The county recorder shall notify the commission of each registered vessel placed in storage. When the owner of a stored vessel desires to renew the vessel's registration, he shall make application to the county recorder and pay the registration fees as provided in subsections 1 and 3 without penalty. No refund of registration fees shall be allowed for a stored vessel.

Sec. 2. Section one hundred six point six (106.6), subsection four (4), Code 1977, is amended by striking the subsection.

Sec. 3. This Act shall be effective January 1, 1979.
