RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR A SCHOOL BOARD SECRETARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session, chapter ninety-seven (97), section two (2), amending section two hundred seventy-nine point three (279.3), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

279.3 APPOINTMENT OF SECRETARY AND TREASURER. At a regular or special meeting of the board held in July prior to or on July fifteenth the board shall appoint a secretary who shall not be a teacher ~~or other~~ employed by the board but may be another employee of the board. It shall also appoint a treasurer who may be another employee of the board. These officers shall be appointed from outside the membership of the board for terms of one year beginning with the date of appointment, and the appointment and qualification shall be entered of record in the minutes of the secretary. They shall qualify within ten days following appointment by taking the oath of office in the manner required by section two hundred seventy-seven point twenty-eight (277.28) of the Code and filing a bond as required by section two hundred ninety-one
