1 Section 1. Notwithstanding sections one hundred twenty-
2 three point two (123.2), section one hundred twenty-three
3 point thirty-six (123.36), subsection six (6), section one
4 hundred twenty-three point forty-nine (123.49), subsection
5 two (2), paragraph b, and section one hundred twenty-three
6 point one hundred thirty-four (123.134), subsection five (5),
7 of the Code, a holder of any class of liquor control license
8 or the holder of a class "B" beer permit may sell or dispense
9 such liquor or beer to patrons for consumption on the premises
10 between the hours of noon, Sunday, December 31, 1978 and two
11 a.m., Monday, January 1, 1979 and beer for consumption off
12 the premises between the hours of noon and ten p.m., Sunday,
13 December 31, 1978. The liquor control license fee or beer
14 permit fee of licensees and permittees permitted to sell or
15 dispense such liquor or beer on this Sunday, December 31,
16 1978, shall not be increased because of this privilege.

17 It is the intent of this section that the special privileges
18 granted shall be in force only during the dates specified
19 in this section.

20 Sec. 2. Section one (1) of this Act is repealed effective
21 January 2, 1979.

22 EXPLANATION

23 This bill provides for an extension of time beer and liquor
24 may be sold by all liquor control licensees and all class
25 "B" permittees whether or not they have been granted a Sunday
26 sales license or permit for consumption on the premises New
27 Years eve, Sunday, December 31, 1978. The hours for "off
28 permises" sale of beer by the liquor control licensees and
29 by all classes of beer permittees would remain the same as
30 regular Sunday hours.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding sections one hundred twenty-three point two (123.2), section one hundred twenty-three point thirty-six (123.36), subsection six (6), section one hundred twenty-three point forty-nine (123.49), subsection two (2), paragraph b, and section one hundred twenty-three point one hundred thirty-four (123.134), subsection five (5), of the Code, a holder of any class of liquor control license or the holder of a class "B" beer permit may sell or dispense such liquor or beer to patrons for consumption on the premises between the hours of noon on Sunday and two a.m. on Monday when that Monday is New Year's Day and beer for consumption off the premises between the hours of noon Sunday and ten p.m. Sunday when that Sunday is the day before New Year's Day. The liquor control license fee or beer permit fee of licensees and permittees permitted to sell or dispense such liquor or beer on a Sunday when that Sunday is the day before New Year's Day shall not be increased because of this privilege.
