1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978 and
3 ending June 30, 1979 to the following named department, the

9 1. For the general of-
10 fice of attorney general for
11 salaries, support, maintenance
12 and miscellaneous purposes \$ 1,657,033

13 a. The funds included
14 within this subsection for
15 the area and special prose-
16 cutors' program are also ap-
17 propriated subject to the
18 condition that the attorney
19 general implement a program
20 which shall provide for bill-
21 ing counties for the costs of
22 services rendered by area and
23 special prosecutors to counties.

24 Costs shall be based upon the
25 actual cost of the legal ser-
26 vice provided. Funds received
27 by the attorney general from
28 counties shall be remitted to
29 the treasurer of state and de-
30 posited in the general fund of
31 the state.

32 b. Counties shall be ex-
33 empt from the payment and bill-
34 ing requirements of paragraph a
35 of this subsection if applica-

1 tion is made to the executive
2 council of the state for the
3 exemption. The executive coun-
4 cil shall approve an exemption
5 if it finds that a conflict of
6 interest exists which prevents
7 county officials from effectively
8 carrying out prosecution duties
9 or if it finds that other extra-
10 ordinary circumstances exist which
11 prevent county officials from ef-
12 fectively prosecuting a criminal
13 case.

14 c. It is the intent of the
15 general assembly that one ad-
16 ditional assistant attorney
17 general position be authorized
18 for use by the state conserva-
19 tion commission, Iowa natural
20 resources council, and depart-
21 ment of environmental quality.

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979 to the following named department, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

1. For the general office of attorney general for salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 1,657,033

a. Funds are included within this subsection for the area and special prosecutor's program.

b. It is the intent of the general assembly that one additional assistant attorney general position be authorized for use by the state conservation commission, Iowa natural resources council, and department of environmental quality. These departments shall reimburse the office of attorney general for the cost of the additional assistant attorney general. It is also the intent of the general assembly

that no reduction in present staff to these departments take place.

c. For printing and distribution of Report of the Attorney General \$ 19,800

2. Prosecuting attorney training program

For salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes \$ 26,500

Funds appropriated by this subsection shall be used to attract federal and county funding.

3. Prosecuting intern program \$ 52,500

Counties participating in the prosecuting intern program shall match funds appropriated by this subsection.

Sec. 2. All federal grants to and the federal receipts of the agency appropriated funds under this division are appropriated for the purposes set forth in such federal grants and receipts.
