A BILL FOR

1 An Act making an appropriation for the inmate employment pro-

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of social services for the
3 fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act
4 and ending June 30, 1979 the sum of four hundred seventy
5 thousand (470,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary,
6 which shall be used to supplement funds previously appropriated
7 for the inmate employment program, and to establish half-way
8 houses at Ames and Marshalltown for the persons participating
9 in the inmate employment program.

10 Sec. 2. The department of social services may establish
11 three new positions by converting existing personnel positions
12 that are vacant. The department shall determine room and
13 board rates for inmates participating in the inmate employment
14 program that are measurable and based upon costs for operation
15 of the half-way houses.

16 Sec. 3. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-nine
17 (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall not
18 be transferred or used for any other purposes other than the
19 purposes specified in section one (1) or two (2) of this Act.

20 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
21 shall take effect and be in force from and after its publica-
22 tion in The Bayard News, a newspaper published in Bayard,
23 Iowa, and in The Marion Sentinel, a newspaper published in
24 Marion, Iowa.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill provides an emergency appropriation to supplement
27 existing funds for the inmate employment program which was
28 created in 1977. See chapter 154, section 27 of the 1977
29 Session Laws. Three new positions are created by converting
30 existing positions that are vacant for work in this program.

AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE INMATE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the department of social services for the fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1979 the sum of four hundred seventy thousand (470,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, which shall be used to supplement funds previously appropriated for the inmate employment program, and to establish half-way houses at Ames and Marshalltown for the persons participating in the inmate employment program.

Sec. 2. The department of social services may establish three new positions by converting existing personnel positions that are vacant. The department shall determine room and board rates for inmates participating in the inmate employment program that are measurable and based upon costs for operation of the half-way houses.

Sec. 3. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-nine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall not be transferred or used for any other purposes other than the purposes specified in section one (1) or two (2) of this Act.

Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Bayard News, a newspaper published in Bayard,
