1 Section 1. Section one hundred eleven A point four
2 (111A.4), subsection three (3), Code 1977, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 3. The county conservation board shall file with and
5 obtain approval of the state conservation commission on all
6 proposals for acquisition of land, and all general develop-
7 ment plans ~~and programs for the improvement and maintenance~~
8 thereof before any such program is executed. Approval of
9 the state conservation commission shall not be necessary
10 unless the cost of the proposed acquisition or development
11 program exceeds twenty-five hundred dollars.

12 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

13 EXPLANATION

14 The bill eliminates the requirement that the county conser-
15 vation board acquire the approval of its improvements and
16 maintenance programs by the state conservation commission.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE IMPROVEMENT AND MAINTENANCE PLANS OF COUNTY
CONSERVATION BOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section one hundred eleven A point four (111A.4), subsection three (3), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

3. The county conservation board shall file with and obtain approval of the state conservation commission on all proposals for acquisition of land, and all general development plans ~~and programs for the improvement and maintenance thereof~~ before any such program is executed. Approval of the state conservation commission shall not be necessary unless the cost of the proposed acquisition or development program exceeds twenty-five hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.
