1 Section 1. Section two hundred twelve point two (212.2),
2 Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

3 212.2 DELIVERY TICKETS REQUIRED. No person shall de-
4 liver any bulk commodities, other than liquids, by vehicle
5 unless otherwise provided for without each such delivery being
6 accompanied by duplicate delivery tickets, on each of which
7 shall be written in ink or other indelible substance the
8 actual weight distinctly expressed in pounds, or kilograms
9 of the gross weight of the load, the tare of the delivery
10 vehicle, and the net amount in weight of the commodity, with
11 or, if the commodity is weighed by hopper scale or belt
12 conveyor, the net weight of the commodity expressed in pounds
13 or kilograms without expression of the tare of the delivery
14 vehicle or the gross weight of the load. The delivery ticket
15 shall display the names of the purchaser and the dealer from
16 whom purchased.

17 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill allows the use of hopper scales or belt conveyor
20 scales to weigh agricultural products within the limitations
21 otherwise provided by law.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WEIGHING OF BULK COMMODITIES BY HOPPER SCALE OR BELT CONVEYOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred twelve point two (212.2), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

212.2 DELIVERY TICKETS REQUIRED. No person shall deliver any bulk commodities, other than liquids, by vehicle unless otherwise provided for without each such delivery being accompanied by duplicate delivery tickets, on each of which shall be written in ink or other indelible substance the actual weight distinctly expressed in pounds, or kilograms of the gross weight of the load, the tare of the delivery vehicle, and the net amount in weight of the commodity, ~~with~~ or, if the commodity is weighed by hopper scale or belt conveyor, the net weight of the commodity expressed in pounds or kilograms without expression of the tare of the delivery vehicle or the gross weight of the load.
