1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the legislative service bureau for the fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 1977 the sum of two thousand five hundred
4 (2,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to
5 be used for per diem and expenses of members of the advisory
6 commission on corrections relief pursuant to Chapter one
7 thousand forty-three (1043), section six (6), Acts of the
8 Sixty-Sixth General Assembly, 1976 Session. The funds
9 appropriated by this Act may be used to pay per diem earned
10 and to reimburse expenses incurred by members of the advisory
11 commission in the discharge of their duties before the
12 effective date of this Act, and not previously paid or
13 reimbursed, as well as to pay per diem earned and to reimburse
14 expenses incurred by the members on or after such date.

15 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
16 shall take effect and be in force from and after its
17 publication in the Quad-City Times, a newspaper published
18 in Davenport, Iowa, and in The Sioux City Journal, a newspaper
19 published in Sioux City, Iowa.

20 EXPLANATION

21 This bill makes a supplementary appropriation of \$2,500
22 for the Advisory Commission on Corrections Relief for the
23 remainder of fiscal 1977. The Commission, which was originally
24 scheduled to go out of existence March 1, 1977 but was later
25 extended until June 30, has spent nearly all of the \$10,000
26 originally appropriated for per diem and expenses of its
27 members.

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the legislative service bureau for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1977 the sum of two thousand five hundred (2,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for per diem and expenses of members of the advisory commission on corrections relief pursuant to chapter one thousand forty-three (1043), section six (6), Acts of the Sixty-sixth General Assembly, 1976 Session. The funds appropriated by this Act may be used to pay per diem earned and to reimburse expenses incurred by members of the advisory commission in the discharge of their duties before the effective date of this Act, and not previously paid or reimbursed, as well as to pay per diem earned and to reimburse expenses incurred by the members on or after such date.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its
