3 is amended to read as follows:

4 a. Chlordiazepoxide, but not chlordiazepoxide hydrochloride and clidinium bromide or chlordiazepoxide and water-
5 soluble esterified estrogens.

7 EXPLANATION

8 The substance chlordiazepoxide was added to schedule IV
9 of the Iowa Uniform Controlled Substances Act by the Sixty-
10 sixth General Assembly in 1976. This bill exempts from regu-
11 lation under that Act two substances which are related to
12 chlordiazepoxide, but which are considered to have no poten-
13 tial for abuse.

TO AMEND THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT WITH RESPECT
TO THE SUBSTANCE CHLORDIAZEPOXIDE, LISTED IN SCHEDULE IV.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred four point two hundred
ten (204.210), subsection five (5), paragraph a, Code 1977,
is amended to read as follows:

a. Chlordiazepoxide, but not chlordiazepoxide hydrochloride and clidinium bromide or chlordiazepoxide and water-soluble esterified estrogens.
