4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund  
2 of the state to the following named agencies subject to the  
3 control of the state board of regents, the following amounts,  
4 or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes  
5 designated:

- 7 For the Linquist center for
- 8 measurement--phase II ..... \$5,500,000
- 9 2. IOWA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF
- 10 For fire safety requirements ..... \$ 95,000
- 11 3. UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA
- 12 For institutional costs associated
- 13 with the Hudson road improvements ..... \$ 195,000
- 14 4. IOWA BRAILLE AND SIGHT-SAVING
- 15 SCHOOL
- 16 a. For fire safety requirements ..... \$ 150,000
- 17 b. For renovation and remodeling ..... \$ 240,000
- 18 5. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS
- 19 For accessibility of facilities
- 20 to the orthopedically handicapped ..... \$ 935,000

21 Sec. 2. Unencumbered or unobligated funds remaining on  
22 June 30, 1981 from funds appropriated by this Act shall revert  
23 to the general fund of the state on September 30, 1981.

24 Sec. 3. Subsection one (1) of section one (1) shall take  
25 effect as provided in section four (4) of this Act.  
26 Subsections two (2), three (3), four (4) and five (5) of  
27 section one (1) are effective July 1, 1977.

28 Sec. 4. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,  
29 shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
30 publication in The Laurens Sun, a newspaper published in  
31 Laurens, Iowa, and in The Aurelia Sentinel, a newspaper  
32 published in Aurelia, Iowa.

33 EXPLANATION

34 This bill makes miscellaneous appropriations for various  
35 projects for the state board of regents and schools named  
36 which are under the control of the board of regents.

Sec. \_\_\_\_ The State Board of Regents and the merged area one (I) board of directors shall coordinate with the Iowa Arts Council all matters relating to the inclusion of works of fine arts in their respective projects authorized by this Act."

APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS AT INSTITUTIONS  
UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE STATE BOARD OF REGENTS AND  
MERGED AREA SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the following named agencies subject to the control of the state board of regents, the following amounts, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the purposes designated:

1. STATE UNIVERSITY OF IOWA  
For the Lindquist center for  
measurement--phase II ..... \$5,500,000
2. IOWA SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF  
For fire safety requirements ..... \$ 95,000
3. UNIVERSITY OF NORTHERN IOWA  
For gymnasium number one perimeter  
renovation ..... \$ 250,000
4. IOWA BRAILLE AND SIGHT-SAVING  
SCHOOL
  - a. For fire safety requirements ..... \$ 150,000
  - b. For renovation and remodeling ..... \$ 240,000
5. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS  
For accessibility of facilities  
to the orthopedically handicapped ..... \$ 935,000
6. IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY  
For a horticulture addition and  
remodeling ..... \$2,460,000

Sec. 2. Chapter two hundred eighty A (280A), Code 1977,  
is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. There is appropriated annually from the general fund of the state to the department of public instruction the sum of five hundred thousand (500,000) dollars to be used for construction projects at merged area one (I) within Dubuque county. This section is repealed effective July 1, 1980.

Sec. 3. Sec. 7. Subsection one (1) of section one (1) shall take effect as provided in section eight (8) of this Act. Subsections two (2), three (3), four (4), five (5) and six (6) of section one (1) are effective July 1, 1977.

Sec. 8. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in The Laurens Sun, a newspaper published in

Laurens, Iowa, and in The Aurelia Sentinel, a newspaper published in Aurelia, Iowa.
