1 An Act to appropriate funds to the department of health
2 to be used to discharge the responsibilities of the
3 department under House File three hundred fifty-four
4 (354), Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly,
5 1977 Session, and to establish the salaries of members
6 of the state health facilities council established
7 by that Act.

1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the state department of health for the fiscal
3 year beginning July 1, 1977 and ending June 30, 1978, the
4 sum of one hundred nineteen thousand one hundred eighty-nine
5 (119,189) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
6 to be used for salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous
7 purposes by the department in discharging its statutory
8 responsibility to begin preparations to implement House File
9 three hundred fifty-four (354), Acts of the Sixty-seventh
10 General Assembly, 1977 Session.

11 Sec. 2. The members of the state health facilities council
12 established by House File three hundred fifty-four (354),
13 section two (2), Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly,
14 1977 Session, shall each receive a salary at the rate of five
15 thousand dollars per year from the date of their respective
16 appointments for the balance of the fiscal year ending June
17 30, 1978. The council members' salaries shall be paid from
18 the funds appropriated by section one (1) of this Act.

EXPLANATION

20 This bill appropriates to the Department of Health \$119,189
21 to pay salaries of the members of the Health Facilities Council
22 and other costs incurred pursuant to the requirement of House
23 File 354 of the 1977 Session that the Council and the
24 Department begin preparations to implement that bill. The
25 substantive and procedural requirements of the bill take
26 effect July 1, 1978. That bill also provides that members
27 of the Council are to receive a salary as fixed by the General
28 Assembly, and this bill establishes those salaries at the
29 annual rate of \$5,000 for the 1977-78 fiscal year. The Council
30 is to have five members.

AN ACT

TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO BE USED TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT UNDER HOUSE FILE THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR (354), ACTS OF THE SIXTY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY, 1977 SESSION, AND TO ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF MEMBERS OF THE STATE HEALTH FACILITIES COUNCIL ESTABLISHED BY THAT ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the state department of health for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1977 and ending June 30, 1978, the sum of sixty-seven thousand three hundred forty-two (67,342) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for salaries, support, maintenance and miscellaneous purposes by the department in discharging its statutory responsibility to begin preparations to implement House File three hundred fifty-four (354), Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session.

Sec. 2. The members of the state health facilities council established by House File three hundred fifty-four (354), section two (2), Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session, shall each receive a salary at the rate of five thousand dollars per year from the date of their respective appointments for the balance of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1978. The council members' salaries shall be paid from the funds appropriated by section one (1) of this Act.

Sec. 3. Acts of the Sixty-seventh General Assembly, 1977 Session, chapter seventy-five (75), is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. CONTRACTS FOR ASSISTANCE WITH ANALYSES, STUDIES AND DATA. In furtherance of the department's

responsibilities under sections sixteen (16), seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) of this chapter, the commissioner may contract with the Iowa hospital association and third party payers, the Iowa health care facilities association and third party payers, or the Iowa association of homes for the aging and third party payers for the establishment of pilot programs dealing with prospective rate review in hospitals or health care facilities, or both.
