2 duty applicable to persons who have been active members of
3 fire companies for ten years.

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred two (102), Code 1977, is
2 repealed.

3 EXPLANATION

4 This bill repeals chapter 102 of the Code. That chapter
5 provides for a jury duty exemption for members of fire
6 companies (fire persons) and contains two types of exemptions:
7 First, section 102.1 exempts active members of fire companies;
8 and second, chapter 102 provides a lifetime exemption for
9 any person who has served as an active member of a fire company
10 for at least ten years.

11 Section 607.2, Code 1977, contains an exemption for "ac-
12 tive members of any fire company", which exemption is not
13 affected by this bill. The effect of repealing chapter 102
14 is thus to eliminate only the lifetime exemption.
