2 after the word "budget." the following: "Any resident  
3 with management capacity may oversee such activities

6 therapeutic benefit or self-satisfaction to a resident  
7 may be done on a voluntary basis. Any proceeds from  
8 these hobbies or activities may be applied for  
9 recreational benefits."

5 contracts and purchases requisite for the county farm and  
6 care facility and may prescribe rules for the management and  
7 government of the same, and for the sobriety, morality and  
8 industry of its occupants. The board of supervisors or the  
9 committee may provide recreational program activities for  
10 residents of the county care facility and provide for the  
11 costs of the activities to be included in the county care  
12 facility's budget.

13 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill authorizes the board of supervisors or the com-  
16 mittee appointed for that purpose to establish and budget  
17 for the costs of maintaining recreational program activities  
18 for residents of county care facilities.

27 Following is the fiscal effect in dollars of the legislative  
proposal as required by Joint Rule 16:

28 House File 74 authorizes the board of supervisors or the committee appointed  
29 for that purpose to establish and budget for the costs of maintaining  
recreational program activities for residents of county care facilities.

30 There are 76 county care facilities in the state. It appears that a  
31 typical county care facility, licensed for 150 residents, would require  
32 a recreational activities budget of approximately \$30,000 per year.

REPORT OF THE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

To the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

We, the undersigned members of the conference committee appointed to consider the difference between the Senate and House of Representatives on House File 74, a bill for an act to provide recreational program activities for residents of county care facilities, respectfully submit the following recommendations:

1. That the Senate recede from its amendment.
2. That the House of Representatives recede from its amendments.
3. That House File 74 be amended as follows:
  - a. Page 1, by striking lines 8 through 13 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

  - b. Amend the title, line 1, by striking the word "recreational".

Section 1. Section two hundred fifty-three point two (253.2), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

253.2 MANAGEMENT. The board of supervisors, or any committee appointed by it for that purpose, may make all contracts and purchases requisite for the county farm and care facility and may prescribe rules for the management and government of the same, and for the sobriety, morality and industry of its occupants. The board of supervisors or the committee shall provide for the costs of the activities program to be included in the county care facility's budget.
