1 Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-four point five
2 (194.5), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

22 that such test is advisable.

23 Sec. 3. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

24 EXPLANATION

25 The U.S. Department of Agriculture recommended standards
26 for milk for manufacturing purposes provides for once a month
27 testing of milk for extraneous matter. The amendments to
28 Sec. 194.5 and 195.13 will provide for the same frequency
29 of testing as that recommended by USDA.
