EXPLANATION

24 OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR. This appropriation of \$409,237
25 is to maintain current levels of existing programs. \$7,100
26 is included for payment of dues in the national governor's
27 conference. There is also a \$5,000 appropriation for office
28 expenses.

29 LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR. This appropriation is to maintain
30 current programs at their present level.

31 EXECUTIVE COUNCIL. This appropriation is to maintain ex-
32 isting programs. It includes the transfer of the executive
33 secretary's salary and support from general services to the
34 executive council's administration.

35 COUNCIL OF STATE GOVERNMENTS. This appropriation of \$27,130

1 is for the membership support of the council.

2 NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATORS. This appropria-
3 tion of \$24,450 is for membership support.

4 LEGISLATIVE FISCAL BUREAU. This appropriation is to
5 maintain current program levels. There is also a \$2,500
6 appropriation for payment of a judicial retirement actuarial
7 study.

8 LEGISLATIVE SERVICE BUREAU. This appropriation is to main-
9 tain current program levels. There is also a \$15,000 appro-
10 priation for the updating of the Iowa Code.

11 CITIZENS AIDE. This appropriation of \$157,324 is to main-
12 tain the current program levels and adds one investigator
13 position for penal institutions.

14 UNIFORM LAWS. This appropriation is to cover expenses
15 and support of the commission.

16 PIONEER LAWMAKERS. This appropriation of \$75 is for sup-
17 port of the pioneer lawmakers.
