1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred fifty-three (153), Code
2 1977, is amended by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. DENTAL COLLEGE FACULTY PERMITS. The state
4 board of dental examiners may issue to members of the faculty
5 of the college of dentistry a faculty permit entitling the
6 holder to practice dentistry or dental hygiene within the
7 college of dentistry and its affiliated teaching facilities
8 as an adjunct to the faculty members' teaching positions,
9 associated responsibilities, and functions. The dean of the
10 college of dentistry shall certify to the state board of
11 dental examiners those bona fide members of the college's
12 faculty who are not licensed and registered to practice
13 dentistry or dental hygiene in Iowa. Any faculty member so
14 certified shall, prior to commencing his or her duties in
15 the college of dentistry, make written application to the
16 state board of dental examiners for a permit. The permit
17 shall expire on the first day of July next following the date
18 of issuance and may at the discretion of the state board of
19 dental examiners, be renewed on a yearly basis. A fee of
20 fifteen dollars shall be paid by the applicant for issuance
21 and renewal of the faculty permit. The fee shall be deposited
22 in the same manner as fees provided for in section one hundred
23 forty-seven point eighty-two (147.82) of the Code. The faculty
24 permit shall be valid during the time the holder remains a
25 member of the faculty of the college of dentistry and shall
26 subject the holder to all provisions of this chapter.

27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill authorizes the board of dental examiners to issue
29 to members of the faculty of the college of dentistry a permit
30 to practice dentistry or dental hygiene within the college
31 of dentistry and affiliated facilities in addition to their
32 teaching responsibilities and associated duties.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PRACTICE OF DENTISTRY AND DENTAL HYGIENE BY
FACULTY OF THE COLLEGE OF DENTISTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred fifty-three (153), Code 1977, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. DENTAL COLLEGE FACULTY PERMITS. The state board of dental examiners may issue to members of the faculty of the college of dentistry a faculty permit entitling the holder to practice dentistry or dental hygiene within the college of dentistry and its affiliated teaching facilities as an adjunct to the faculty members' teaching positions, associated responsibilities, and functions. The dean of the college of dentistry shall certify to the state board of dental examiners those bona fide members of the college's faculty who are not licensed and registered to practice dentistry or dental hygiene in Iowa. Any faculty member so certified shall, prior to commencing his or her duties in the college of dentistry, make written application to the state board of dental examiners for a permit. The permit shall expire on the first day of July next following the date of issuance and may at the discretion of the state board of dental examiners, be renewed on a yearly basis. A fee of fifteen dollars shall be paid by the applicant for issuance and renewal of the faculty permit. The fee shall be deposited in the same manner as fees provided for in section one hundred forty-seven point eighty-two (147.82) of the Code. The faculty permit shall be valid during the time the holder remains a

member of the faculty of the college of dentistry and shall subject the holder to all provisions of this chapter.
