1 Section 1. There is appropriated to the state comptroller  
2 from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year  
3 beginning July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979 the sum of  
4 eight thousand five hundred seventy-one dollars and seventy-  
5 five cents (\$8,571.75), or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
6 to be used to pay legal expenses of the respondent in state  
7 of Iowa ex rel. Richard Turner v. John Scott, respondent.  
8 The attorney of record shall submit to the state comptroller  
9 in the manner required by the state comptroller the claim  
10 for such legal expenses. The state comptroller shall pay  
11 to the attorney of record the amount claimed upon receipt  
12 of such claim.

13 Sec. 2. The acceptance of funds appropriated by this Act  
14 by the attorney of record shall be in full settlement of all  
15 claims against the state because of the above described claim.

19 of Iowa v. Scott.

AN ACT  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR CERTAIN LEGAL FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated to the state comptroller from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1978 and ending June 30, 1979 the sum of eight thousand five hundred seventy-one dollars and seventy-five cents (\$8,571.75), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used to pay legal expenses of the respondent in state of Iowa ex rel. Richard Turner v. John Scott, respondent. The attorney of record shall submit to the state comptroller in the manner required by the state comptroller the claim for such legal expenses. The state comptroller shall pay to the attorney of record the amount claimed upon receipt of such claim.

Sec. 2. The acceptance of funds appropriated by this Act by the attorney of record shall be in full settlement of all claims against the state because of the above described claim.
