1 WHEREAS, the city council of the city of Charter Oak
2 let a contract for the construction of tennis courts
3 situated within the city of Charter Oak; and

4 WHEREAS, the city council of the city of Charter Oak
5 complied with all of the provisions of the law, except
6 that the city council failed to give proper notice of
7 the date, place and time of the bid openings by proper
8 publication prior to the date of the acceptance of the
9 same; and

10 WHEREAS, some doubt has arisen as to the validity of
11 the contract executed between the city of Charter Oak
12 and L and H Construction Inc., for the construction of
13 the tennis courts and said act and contract should be
14 legalized and the matter once and for all be put to rest;

15 NOW THEREFORE,

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

17 Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the city
18 council of the city of Charter Oak, pertaining to the
19 letting of a contract for the construction of tennis
20 courts where the city council failed to properly publish
21 notice of the time, place and date of the bid opening,
22 are validated, legalized and confirmed and shall constitute
23 a valid, legal and binding contract for the construction of
24 said tennis courts.

25 EXPLANATION

26 The bill legalizes a contract executed between the city
27 of Charter Oak and a contractor which contract for the
28 construction of tennis courts in the city of Charter Oak
29 was executed pursuant to a bid but where the city council
30 failed to give proper notice of the date, place, and time
31 of the opening of bids.

AN ACT

TO LEGALIZE PROCEEDINGS TAKEN BY THE CITY OF CHARTER OAK RELATING TO THE LETTING OF CERTAIN CONTRACTS.

WHEREAS, the city council of the city of Charter Oak let a contract for the construction of tennis courts situated within the city of Charter Oak; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the city of Charter Oak complied with all of the provisions of the law, except that the city council failed to give proper notice of the date, place and time of the bid openings by proper publication prior to the date of the acceptance of the same; and

WHEREAS, some doubt has arisen as to the validity of the contract executed between the city of Charter Oak and L and H Construction Inc., for the construction of the tennis courts and said act and contract should be legalized and the matter once and for all be put to rest; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the city council of the city of Charter Oak, pertaining to the letting of a contract for the construction of tennis courts where the city council failed to properly publish notice of the time, place and date of the bid opening, are validated, legalized and
