MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO MISCELLANEOUS STATE AGENCIES INCLUDING THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS, BOARD OF NURSE EXAMINERS, BOARD OF PHARMACY EXAMINERS, IOWA HOUSING FINANCE AUTHORITY, IOWA MENTAL HEALTH AUTHORITY, BOARD OF PAROLE, COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN, SPANISH-SPEAKING PEOPLES COMMISSION, COMMITTEE ON THE EMPLOYMENT OF THE HANDICAPPED, AND THE SPANISH-AMERICAN WAR VETERANS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF MULTI-YEAR LICENSES BY CERTAIN EXAMINING BOARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
