1 Section 1. Section one hundred seven point twenty-four
2 (107.24), subsection nine (9), Code 1977, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 9. Provide for the protection against fire and other
5 destructive agencies on state and privately owned ~~forest-and~~
6 forests, parks, wildlife areas and other property under its
7 jurisdiction, and to co-operate with federal and other state
8 agencies in protection programs approved by the conservation
9 commission, and with the consent of the owner on privately
10 owned areas.

11 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill authorizes the state conservation commission
14 to provide protection against fire and other destructive
15 agencies on properties under its jurisdiction which are not
16 included under present law. These properties include those
17 of historic, scientific, or recreational significance not
18 located on state or privately owned forest lands or in wildlife
19 areas.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION FOR ITS PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section one hundred seven point twenty-four (107.24), subsection nine (9), Code 1977, is amended to read as follows:

9. Provide for the protection against fire and other destructive agencies on state and privately owned ~~forest-and~~ forests, parks, wildlife areas and other property under its jurisdiction, and to co-operate with federal and other state agencies in protection programs approved by the conservation commission, and with the consent of the owner on privately owned areas.

Sec. 2. This Act is effective January 1, 1978.
