9 This bill provides for publication of an interim supplement

The interim supplement to the Code shall be published in substantially the style of the Code of Iowa. The provisions of chapters fourteen (14) and eighteen (18) of the Code as they relate to the Code of Iowa shall apply to the publication and distribution of the interim supplement except where inconsistent with this section. The text of the criminal code revision as published in the interim supplement shall be incorporated into the 1979 Code of Iowa.

The legislative council in cooperation with the state printer may obtain and approve bids for the publication of the interim supplement and may contract for necessary services required in the publication of the interim supplement. Expenses for the preparation and publication of the interim supplement shall be paid from funds appropriated by section fourteen point twenty-two (14.22) of the Code. The state comptroller shall pay such expenses upon the submission of proper vouchers approved by the director of the legislative service bureau.

The code editor, state comptroller, and state printer shall cooperate to carry out the provisions of this section.

SEC. 531.
