EXPLANATION

10 This bill deletes two grounds from those which may be cited
11 in a petition for termination of parental rights. Although
12 termination may be ordered by the court on these two grounds,
13 they would not have arisen at the time a petition is filed.

14 The bill takes effect on January first following its
15 enactment.
