1 Section 1. Section one hundred seven point twenty-four
2 (107.24), Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new
3 subsection:

4 NEW SUBSECTION. Establish a program governing the
5 harvesting and sale of American ginseng subject to the
6 convention on international trade in endangered species of
7 wild fauna and flora and adopt rules providing for the time
8 and conditions for the harvesting of the ginseng, the
9 registration of dealers and exporters, the records kept by
10 dealers and exporters, and the certification of legal taking.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill authorizes the state conservation commission
13 to establish a regulatory program for dealers and exporters
14 of American ginseng. American ginseng is subject to the
15 convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of
16 Wild Fauna and Flora. The implementing regulations of the
17 United States fish and wildlife service require a state
18 regulatory program for the ginseng to be eligible for export.
