1 An Act to provide for the reimbursement of expenses  
2 incurred by the county and city members of the state  
3 functional classification review board and making an

1 Section 1. Section three hundred six point six (306.6),  
2 subsection two (2), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1979,  
3 is amended to read as follows:

4 There is created a state functional classification review  
5 board which shall consist of one state senator appointed by  
6 the president of the senate, one state representative appointed  
7 by the speaker of the house of representatives, one supervisor  
8 appointed by the Iowa state association of county supervisors,  
9 one engineer appointed by the Iowa county engineers'  
10 association, two persons appointed by the league of Iowa  
11 municipalities, one of whom shall be a licensed professional  
12 engineer, and two persons appointed by the department, one  
13 of whom shall be a commissioner and the other a staff member.  
14 This board shall select a permanent ~~chairman~~ chairperson from  
15 among its members by majority vote of the total membership.  
16 The ~~chairman~~ chairperson and all members of the board shall  
17 serve without additional compensation except that the  
18 supervisor appointed by the Iowa state association of county  
19 supervisors, the engineer appointed by the Iowa county  
20 engineers' association, and the two persons appointed by the  
21 league of Iowa municipalities shall be reimbursed for their  
22 actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance  
23 of their official duties as members of the board. All expenses  
24 shall be paid from funds allocated under section two (2) of  
25 this Act.

26 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twelve point two (312.2),  
27 Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

28 NEW SUBSECTION. The treasurer of state, before making  
29 the allotments provided in this section, shall credit annually  
30 to the primary road fund from the road use tax fund the sum  
31 of five thousand dollars to be used by the state department  
32 of transportation for payment of expenses authorized under  
33 section three hundred six point six (306.6), subsection two  
34 (2), of the Code. The expense allowance shall be in accordance  
35 with the established expense reimbursement policy for employees

1 of the state department of transportation. All unobligated  
2 funds shall at the end of each fiscal year revert to the road  
3 use tax fund.

4 EXPLANATION

5 The bill makes a standing annual appropriation of \$5,000  
6 from the road use tax fund to the primary road fund to be  
7 used for reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses  
8 incurred by the county and city members of the state functional  
9 classification review board in the performance of their  
10 official duties as members of the board. The payments will  
11 be made by the state department of transportation. The bill  
12 is effective July first following enactment.

AN ACT

TO PROVIDE FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE COUNTY AND CITY MEMBERS OF THE STATE FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION REVIEW BOARD AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred six point six (306.6), subsection two (2), unnumbered paragraph one (1), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

There is created a state functional classification review board which shall consist of one state senator appointed by the president of the senate, one state representative appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives, one supervisor appointed by the Iowa state association of county supervisors, one engineer appointed by the Iowa county engineers' association, two persons appointed by the league of Iowa municipalities, one of whom shall be a licensed professional engineer, and two persons appointed by the department, one of whom shall be a commissioner and the other a staff member. This board shall select a permanent ~~chairman~~ chairperson from among its members by majority vote of the total membership. The ~~chairman~~ chairperson and all members of the board shall serve without additional compensation except that the supervisor appointed by the Iowa state association of county supervisors, the engineer appointed by the Iowa county engineers' association, and the two persons appointed by the league of Iowa municipalities shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties as members of the board. All expenses shall be paid from funds allocated under section two (2) of this Act.

Sec. 2. Section three hundred twelve point two (312.2), Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new subsection: NEW SUBSECTION. The treasurer of state, before making the allotments provided in this section, shall credit annually to the primary road fund from the road use tax fund the sum of five thousand dollars to be used by the state department of transportation for payment of expenses authorized under section three hundred six point six (306.6), subsection two (2), of the Code. The expense allowance shall be in accordance with the established expense reimbursement policy for employees of the state department of transportation. All unobligated funds shall at the end of each fiscal year revert to the road use tax fund.
