1 Section 1. Chapter three hundred thirty-seven (337), Code
2 1979, is amended by adding the following new section:

3 NEW SECTION. ADDITIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT. If a tract of
4 land is owned by a corporation organized under chapter four
5 hundred ninety-one (491) of the Code with assets of the value
6 of one million dollars or more which has one or more platted
7 villages located within the territorial limits of the tract
8 of land, all of the territory within the plats of the villages
9 with their addition or subdivisions shall, for the purposes
10 of this section, be deemed to be one incorporated city. The
11 corporation may assess and collect funds from its property
12 owners for the purpose of obtaining additional law enforcement
13 services from the county sheriff. The corporation may contract
14 under chapter twenty-eight E (28E) of the Code with the county
15 sheriff for additional law enforcement services.

16 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January first following
17 its enactment.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill allows the Amana Colonies to contract with the
20 county sheriff for additional law enforcement services.
