1 WHEREAS, it appears from the records of the board of
2 supervisors of Clay county, Iowa, that at a special election
3 held in the county on November 6, 1979, the proposition of
4 issuing bonds of the county in the sum of five hundred thousand
5 (500,000) dollars for the purpose of remodeling and
6 reconstructing the Clay county courthouse, purchasing real
7 estate, and erecting, constructing and equipping a new county
8 administration building in the county, was approved by more
9 than sixty percent of the total number of votes cast for and
10 against the proposition, and after the election the board
11 of supervisors by resolution authorized the issuance of the
12 county building bonds as authorized by the election proposition
13 and made provision for the levy of taxes to pay the bonds
14 and the interest on the bonds; and

15 WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning legal sufficiency
16 of the election and the proceedings for the issuance and
17 payment of the bonds and it is deemed advisable to put the
18 doubts and all those that might arise concerning the same
19 at rest; NOW THEREFORE,

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

21 Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the board of
22 supervisors of Clay county, Iowa, relating to the election
23 on the county building bonds held in the county on November
24 6, 1979, and all proceedings providing for the issuance and
25 delivery of county building bonds of the county in the amount
26 of five hundred thousand (500,000) dollars pursuant to the
27 election and for the levy of taxes to pay the bonds and
28 interest on the bonds, are legalized and the county building
29 bonds issued, sold and delivered pursuant to and in accordance
30 with the proceedings are legal and binding obligations of
31 the county.

32 Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
33 takes effect from and after its publication in The Daily
34 Reporter, a newspaper published in Spencer, Iowa, and the
35 Peterson Patriot, a newspaper published in Peterson, Iowa,

1 without expense to the state.

2 EXPLANATION

3 This bill legalizes the proceedings of the Clay county
4 board of supervisors relating to an election to authorize
5 the issuance of county building bonds held on November 6,
6 1979 and proceedings relating to the issuance of the county
7 building bonds and the levy of a property tax to pay the
8 principal and interest on the bonds. This legalizing Act
9 is necessitated by a typographical error on the election
10 ballot in stating the property tax rate to be levied at
11 fourteen hundredths (.14) cents per thousand dollars of
12 assessed valuation rather than fourteen (14) cents per thousand
13 dollars of assessed valuation.

AN ACT

TO LEGALIZE THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CLAY COUNTY, IOWA, RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF COUNTY BUILDING BONDS AND THE LEVY OF TAXES FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST ON THE BONDS.

WHEREAS, it appears from the records of the board of supervisors of Clay county, Iowa, that at a special election held in the county on November 6, 1979, the proposition of issuing bonds of the county in the sum of five hundred thousand (\$500,000) dollars for the purpose of remodeling and reconstructing the Clay county courthouse, purchasing real estate, and erecting, constructing and equipping a new county administration building in the county, was approved by more than sixty percent of the total number of votes cast for and against the proposition, and after the election the board of supervisors by resolution authorized the issuance of the county building bonds as authorized by the election proposition and made provision for the levy of taxes to pay the bonds and the interest on the bonds; and

WHEREAS, doubts have arisen concerning legal sufficiency of the election and the proceedings for the issuance and payment of the bonds and it is deemed advisable to put the doubts and all those that might arise concerning the same at rest; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the board of supervisors of Clay county, Iowa, relating to the election on the county building bonds held in the county on November 6, 1979, and all proceedings providing for the issuance and delivery of county building bonds of the county in the amount

of five hundred thousand (500,000) dollars pursuant to the election and for the levy of taxes to pay the bonds and interest on the bonds, are legalized and the county building bonds issued, sold and delivered pursuant to and in accordance with the proceedings are legal and binding obligations of the county.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect from and after its publication in The Daily Reporter, a newspaper published in Spencer, Iowa, and the Peterson Patriot, a newspaper published in Peterson, Iowa, without expense to the state.
