7 EXPLANATION

8 Present law requires the clerk of the district court to
9 maintain several categories of books for maintenance of various
10 court records. This bill would allow the maintenance of the
11 records on computer, provided the records remain readily
12 accessible. The bill takes effect July first following its
13 enactment.

RELATING TO THE USE OF COMPUTERS FOR THE STORAGE OF COURT RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section six hundred six point seven (606.7), Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The provisions of this section do not prohibit the storage of all the required records on computer, provided the records remain readily accessible.

Sec. 2. Chapter six hundred ninety-two (692), Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new section:

NEW SECTION. DATA TO ARRESTING AGENCY. The clerk of the district court shall forward conviction and disposition data
