TO INCREASE THE MINIMUM COST OF REPAIRS TO SCHOOL BUILDINGS FOR WHICH BID PROCEDURES ARE REQUIRED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section two hundred ninety-seven point eight (297.8), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

297.8 EMERGENCY REPAIRS.
