27 EXPLANATION

28 This bill makes several changes in the statute relating
29 to what are currently called local advisory committees for
30 vocational education. The bill changes the designation from
31 committee to council and makes some changes in the composition
32 of the councils. It requires a school board receiving federal
33 funds for vocational education, regardless of the size of
34 the community, to appoint a council. The membership of the
35 councils must emphasize business, industry and labor. Councils

1 may be organized according to program area, school, community
2 or region. The bill will be effective July first following
3 its enactment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

The board of directors of any a school district ~~having a population of more than five thousand persons, maintaining that maintains~~ a school, department, or class receiving ~~the benefit of federal moneys~~ federal or state funds under ~~the provisions of~~ this chapter shall, as a condition of approval by ~~such the~~ state board ~~as herein provided~~, appoint a local advisory ~~committee~~ council for vocational education, ~~consisting composed of persons of experience in agriculture, industry, home economics, and business, to~~ public members with emphasis on persons representing business, agriculture, industry and labor. The local advisory council shall give advice and assistance to ~~such the~~ board of directors in the establishment and maintenance of ~~such~~ schools, departments, and classes that receive federal or state funds under this chapter. ~~The state board may require the board of directors of any school district that maintains an approved school, department, or class, to appoint such an advisory committee.~~ Local advisory councils may be organized according to program area, school, community or region. The state board shall adopt rules requiring that the memberships of local advisory ~~committees~~ councils fairly

represent each sex and minorities residing in the school district. Members of such an advisory committee council shall serve without compensation.
