 2 (410.18), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:
 3 410.18 HOSPITAL EXPENSE. Cities shall provide hospital,
 4 nursing, and medical attention for the members of the police
 5 and fire departments of such cities, when injured while in
 6 the performance of their duties as members of such department,
 7 and for members being paid a pension by the city under section
 8 four hundred ten point eight (410.8) of the Code, and the
 9 cost of such hospital, nursing, and medical attention shall
 10 be paid out of the appropriation for the department to which
 11 such injured person belongs; provided that any amounts received
 12 by such injured person under the workers' compensation law
 13 of the state, or from any other source for such specific
 14 purposes, shall be deducted from the amount paid by such city

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PAYMENT OF HOSPITALIZATION AND MEDICAL BENEFITS FOR CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section four hundred ten point eighteen (410.18), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

410.18 HOSPITAL EXPENSE. Cities shall provide hospital, nursing, and medical attention for the members of the police and fire departments of such cities, when injured while in the performance of their duties as members of such department, and for members being paid a pension by the city under section four hundred ten point eight (410.8) of the Code for a disability contracted while the member was engaged in the performance of duties, and the cost of such hospital, nursing, and medical attention shall be paid out of the appropriation for the department to which such injured person belongs; provided that any amounts received by such injured person under the workers' compensation law of the state, or from any other source for such specific purposes, shall be deducted from the amount paid by such city under the provisions of this section.

Sec. 2. Section four hundred eleven point fifteen (411.15), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

411.15 HOSPITALIZATION AND MEDICAL ATTENTION. Cities shall provide hospital, nursing, and medical attention for the members of the police and fire departments of such cities, when injured while in the performance of their duties as members of such department, and for members receiving a retirement allowance under section four hundred eleven point six (411.6), subsection six (6) of the Code for an injury or disease incurred in or aggravated by the actual performance of duty, and the cost of such hospital, nursing, and medical

attention shall be paid out of the appropriation for the department to which such injured person belongs; provided that any amounts received by such injured person under the workers' compensation law of the state, or from any other source for such specific purposes, shall be deducted from the amount paid by such city under the provisions of this section.

Sec. 3. This Act is effective January first following its enactment.
