14 EXPLANATION

15 The objective of this bill is to bring Iowa's state Uniform  
16 Controlled Substances Act into conformity with the federal  
17 controlled substances law. The specific substances to which  
18 federal law is applicable are updated on a continuing basis  
19 by regulation.

20 Sections 1 and 2 revise the list of schedule I opiate drugs  
21 by deleting dextrorphan and adding difenoxin and propiram.  
22 (This is done in two sections so as to avoid reprinting the  
23 entire lengthy subsection in this bill.) Section 3 adds  
24 drotebanol to the list of schedule I opium derivatives and  
25 section 5 adds a depressant--mecloqualone--to schedule I for  
26 the first time. Schedule I consists of dangerous drugs having  
27 no recognized medical use.

28 Section 4 adds three separate analogs of phencyclidine  
29 to the list of schedule I hallucinogenic substances. Sections  
30 6 and 7 move phencyclidine itself (often referred to as PCP  
31 or "angel dust") from schedule III to schedule II. Schedule  
32 II includes the most dangerous drugs for which there are  
33 recognized medical uses.

34 The remaining sections of the bill add a series of new  
35 substances to schedules IV and V, the relatively less dangerous

1 drugs for which the potential for abuse does exist.  
2 Because it is desirable that the list of substances  
3 controlled under Iowa law be updated at an early time, the  
4 delayed effective date clause being included in many of the  
5 bills prepared for the Sixty-eighth General Assembly is not  
6 used in this bill.
