1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state to the department of social services for the

14 nine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall

AN ACT

MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
SOCIAL SERVICES FOR AID TO DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
of the state to the department of social services for the
fiscal period beginning with the effective date of this Act
and ending June 30, 1979 the sum of two million six hundred
fifty thousand (2,650,000) dollars, or so much thereof as
is necessary, which shall be used only to supplement existing
appropriations for the aid to dependent children program
maintained under chapter two hundred thirty-nine (239) of
the Code.

Sec. 2. Any unencumbered or unexpended funds not used
for the purpose specified in section one (1) of this Act and
remaining on June 30, 1979, shall revert to the general fund
of the state. Notwithstanding section eight point thirty-
nine (8.39) of the Code, funds appropriated by this Act shall
not be subject to transfer or expenditure for any purpose
other than the purpose specified in section one (1) of this
Act.
