1 Section 1. Section six hundred nine point five (609.5),  
2 Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:  
3 609.5 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION PROVIDED. For the purpose  
4 of aiding the appointive commission in drawing the jury lists,  
5 officials of the state and its political subdivisions shall  
6 furnish the appointive commission with copies of the current  
7 list of registered voters, ~~tax-assessments-lists~~, lists of  
8 persons holding motor vehicle operators' licenses, or such  
9 other comprehensive lists of persons residing in the county  
10 as the commission may request. The clerk of the district  
11 court shall also deliver to the commission a list of all  
12 persons who have served as grand or petit jurors since January  
13 1 first of the preceding year.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill strikes the requirement of furnishing tax  
16 assessments lists to county jury commissions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

I hereby certify that this bill originated in the House and is known as House File 715, Sixty-eighth General Assembly.

Section 1. Section six hundred nine point five (609.5), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

609.5 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION PROVIDED. For the purpose of aiding the appointive commission in drawing the jury lists, officials of the state and its political subdivisions shall furnish the appointive commission with copies of the current list of registered voters, ~~tax-assessments-lists~~, lists of persons holding motor vehicle operators' licenses, or such other comprehensive lists of persons residing in the county as the commission may request.
