22 This bill provides that a person who serves colored oleo,  
23 oleomargarine, or margarine at a public eating place has the  
24 option of providing notice of the fact in several ways.

Section 1. Section one hundred ninety-one point three (191.3), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

No person shall ~~possess-in-a-form-ready-for-serving~~ serve colored oleo, oleomargarine or margarine at a public eating place unless a notice that oleo, oleomargarine or margarine is served is displayed prominently and conspicuously in such place and in ~~such a~~ such a manner as to render it likely to be read and understood by the ordinary individual being served in ~~such the~~ the eating place or is printed or is otherwise set forth on the menu in type or lettering not smaller than that normally used to designate the serving of other food items--~~No person shall serve colored oleo, oleomargarine or margarine at a public eating place, whether or not any charge is made therefor;~~ or unless each separate serving bears or is accompanied by labeling identifying it as oleo, oleomargarine or margarine, or each separate serving thereof is triangular in shape.
