2 (618.11), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

6 allowed by law, shall not exceed ~~twenty-four~~ twenty-six cents
7 for one insertion, and ~~sixteen~~ seventeen cents for each
8 subsequent insertion, for each line of eight-point type two
9 inches in length, or the equivalent thereof. In case of
10 controversy or doubt regarding measurements, style, manner
11 or form, ~~said~~ the controversy ~~shall-be~~ is referred to the

16 This bill increases from twenty-four to twenty-six cents

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY: SENATOR NYSTROM

In compliance with a written request received February 5, 19 79, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 183 pursuant to Joint Rule 16. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

Senate File 183, An Act relating to the maximum rates that may be paid for publication of notices, orders or other materials as required by law or ordinance.

This bill increases from twenty-four to twenty-six cents per line the maximum rate that a unit of government may pay for the first insertion of a legal notice or order or other material required to be published by law or ordinance. The rate for each subsequent insertion is changed from sixteen to seventeen cents per line.

Composite cost figures of current publication expense is not readily available. The increase proposed represents slightly over 8%. It is estimated the total cost to local governmental entities would be in the area of \$100,000 per year.
