In compliance with a written request received February 1, 19 80, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for S.F. 2123 pursuant to Joint Rule 16. Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, to members of the Legislature upon request.

S.F. 2123, An Act relating to expenditures for uniforms and accessories for sheriffs and deputy sheriffs.

Probably insignificant cost increase because counties have currently been purchasing necessary equipment even though law didn't allow it. The Auditor has objected to these purchases in some cases. In other cases, the counties have used the \$300 annual limitation to fully equip deputies. This required the deputy to operate partially equipped for some period of time. The annual maintenance allowance can usually be held to about \$150 once the deputy is fully equipped.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill removes the expenditure limitation for the initial  
 16 issue of uniforms and accessories for sheriffs and deputy  
 17 sheriffs. The current limitation per person is three hundred  
 18 dollars in a calendar year, but the current estimated cost  
 19 of an initial issue of uniforms and accessories per person  
 20 is one thousand dollars. After the year in which the initial  
 21 issue is supplied, the annual expenditure is limited to three  
 22 hundred dollars for each individual. The expenditure limita-  
 23 tion is also changed from a calendar year to a fiscal year  
 24 basis.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-seven A point two (337A.2), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:  
337A.2 FURNISHED BY COUNTY. The county board of supervisors shall provide the sheriff and ~~his~~ the sheriff's full-time ~~bonded~~ deputies with all uniforms and accessories deemed necessary by the sheriff for properly outfitting the sheriff and his deputies. ~~The expenditure for uniforms and accessories shall not exceed three hundred dollars per man in any calendar year. The uniforms and accessories remain~~ the property of the county.

Sec. 2. Section three hundred thirty-two point ten (332.10), unnumbered paragraph two (2), Code 1979, is amended by striking the unnumbered paragraph.
