AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STORAGE OF A REGISTERED SNOWMOBILE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one G point four (321G.4), Code 1979, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. If a snowmobile is placed in storage, the owner shall return the current registration certificate to the county recorder with an affidavit stating that the snowmobile is placed in storage and the effective date of storage. The county recorder shall notify the commission of each snowmobile placed in storage. When the owner of a stored snowmobile desires to renew the registration, the owner shall make application to the county recorder and pay the registration and writing fees without penalty. A refund of the registration fee shall not be allowed for a stored snowmobile.
