1 Section 1. Notwithstanding sections thirty-nine point  
2 eight (39.8), thirty-nine point eighteen (39.18) and three  
3 hundred thirty-one point one (331.1) of the Code, the term  
4 of office of a county supervisor elected to that office in  
5 November, 1976, for a four-year term which commenced in  
6 January, 1978, shall expire on the first day of January, 1982,  
7 which is not a Sunday or legal holiday. A successor to that  
8 office of county supervisor shall be elected at the general  
9 election in November, 1980, for a three-year term which shall  
10 commence in January, 1982, and expire on the first day of  
11 January, 1985, which is not a Sunday or legal holiday.  
12 Thereafter, the term of office of a successor to that office  
13 of county supervisor shall be four years, except as otherwise  
14 provided by section three hundred thirty-one point twenty-  
15 five (331.25), subsection two (2) or three hundred thirty-  
16 one point twenty-six (331.26), subsection four (4) of the  
17 Code.

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides a three-year term for a Calhoun county  
20 supervisor who is elected in November, 1980, to succeed a  
21 county supervisor who was elected in November, 1976, but whose  
22 four-year term of office did not commence until January, 1978.  
23 The single three-year term for the person elected to that  
24 supervisor office in November, 1980 will correct the present  
25 situation where the transition from a three-year term to a  
26 four-year term under Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly,  
27 1969 Session, chapter 218 was not properly made.

Amend Senate File 2370 as follows:

1. By striking everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"Section 1. This bill provides a three-year term for a Calhoun county supervisor who is elected in November, 1980, to succeed a county supervisor who was elected in November, 1976, but whose four-year term of office did not commence until January, 1978. The single three-year term for the person elected to that supervisor office in November, 1980 will correct the present situation where the transition from a three-year term to a four-year term under Acts of the Sixty-third General Assembly, 1969 Session, chapter 218 was not properly made."

2. Amend the explanation by striking lines 19 through 27 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"Notwithstanding sections thirty-nine point eight (39.8), thirty-nine point eighteen (39.18) and three hundred thirty-one point one (331.1) of the Code, the term of office of a county supervisor elected to that office in November, 1976, for a four-year term which commenced in January, 1978, shall expire on the first day of January, 1982, which is not a Sunday or legal holiday. A successor to that office of county supervisor shall be elected at the general election in November, 1980, for a three-year term which shall commence in January, 1982, and expire on the first day of January, 1985, which is not a Sunday or legal holiday. Thereafter, the term of office of a successor to that office of county supervisor shall be four years, except as otherwise provided by section three hundred thirty-one point twenty-five (331.25), subsection two (2) or three hundred thirty-one point twenty-six (331.26), subsection four (4) of the Code."
