2 (332.9), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

3 332.9 OFFICES FURNISHED. The board of supervisors shall

5 treasurer, auditor, county attorney, county surveyor or
6 engineer, and county assessor, with offices at the county
7 seat, ~~but in~~. The board of supervisors shall also furnish
8 the sheriff with offices within the county. In no case shall
9 any such officer, except the county attorney, be permitted
10 to occupy an office also occupied by a practicing attorney.

11 Sec. 2. This Act is effective January first following
12 its enactment.

13 EXPLANATION

14 This bill provides that a board of supervisors may fur-
15 nish the sheriff with offices anywhere within the county
16 rather than only in the county seat.

PROVIDING THAT A BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY FURNISH THE SHERIFF WITH AN OFFICE ANYWHERE WITHIN THE COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section three hundred thirty-two point nine (332.9), Code 1979, is amended to read as follows:

332.9 OFFICES FURNISHED. The board of supervisors shall furnish the clerk of the district court, ~~sheriff~~, recorder, treasurer, auditor, county attorney, county surveyor or engineer, and county assessor, with offices at the county seat, ~~but in~~. The board of supervisors shall also furnish the sheriff with offices within the county. In no case shall any such officer, except the county attorney, be permitted
